## Principal update-

Guest Jennifer to speak about childcare at our school!!!

Context- 3 SD's in province selected for pilot program. Province need to improve before and after care for school aged children. Operates under childcare regulations and needs to be integrated into the school, to help improve transition to school. "all in one" model, kids feel safe and have all their school and care needs provided in one place, seamless transitions. SEPT 2025!!! Licenced, approx. 51 spaces (k-12gr). Fully inclusive and need based care. Programs are age/grade based. K approx. 12 spaces, gr.1-2 22 spaces, gr 3+ remaining. All teachers will be district staff, mostly EA's with partial hours. Also ECE's. Open 7.20am to 5.30pm and most non-instructional days, plus spring break and summer

(operated out of BX)

Child lead, indoor/outdoor, snack included.

Monthly fee, K- \$567 less grant 320=247/m. Gr1 up \$566 less 115= 451/m plus there are household income/needs/indigenous benefits to have fee reduced more. Spring and summer care is separate fee/registration process. Not funded through the K-12 system, this program does not take from the existing school operating budget.
